VZKAZ OD PREZIDENTA

Vážení členové,

Tour de France dominuje měsíci červenci a ani letošní rok nebyl výjimkou.

Grand Depart v Dánsku byl obrovským úspěchem a byl jsem potěšen, že jsem byl v Kodani na

krátké a ostré zahajovací časovce a na druhé více než 200 km dlouhé etapě, která peloton zavedla po velkolepém mostě, který se klene přes úžinu Great Belt. Dánská veřejnost byla v plné síle a všude davy povzbuzovaly sportovce.

Jak víte, 9. a 10. července zavítala Tour de France také do Švýcarska, s příjezdem 8 etapa v olympijském hlavním městě Lausanne, kde sídlí Mezinárodní olympijský výbor, poté start další etapy v Aigle, městě, kde sídlí naše centrála UCI. Peloton projel dvakrát kolem našeho UCI WCC: krátce po startu etapy a znovu před stoupáním na Châtel – Portes du Soleil ve Francii.

Kromě pořádání "Relais-Etape" ASO vytvořilo Světové cyklistické centrum UCI po oba dny fanouškovskou zónu, která přilákala obrovské množství cyklistů, rodin a fanoušků. Mohli sledovat závody na obří obrazovce a užít si řadu aktivit, jako jsou bezplatné úvodní kurzy pro závody na dráze a BMX, prohlídky Světového cyklistického centra UCI, včetně výstavy Tour de France, a hry pro děti.

Také jsem sledoval etapa z Morzine – Les Portes du Soleil do Megève a v neděli 24. července se pojede v Paříži do cíle na Champs Elysées, což je vždy neuvěřitelný zážitek. Letos to bude o to výjimečnější, že ve stejný den vyrazí Tour de France Femmes – historický okamžik pro ženskou cyklistiku, který dále osvětlí pozornost těchto neuvěřitelných sportovců.

Chtěl bych zde zmínit, že Giro Donne, které skončilo 10. července, přilákalo rekordní televizní publikum s více než 20 miliony diváků po celém světě v 10 etapách italského závodu. To je skutečným znamením rostoucí a zasloužené popularity a uznání ženské cyklistiky.

Profesionální ženské a mužské pelotony sice nepřestávají předvádět show, ale také čerpám velké uspokojení z toho, že jsem byl svědkem procházející další generace cyklistů. Bylo tedy velkým potěšením cestovat do Anadie (Portugalsko) na silniční závody mistrovství Evropy mládeže UEC v cyklistice. Tato oslava cyklistiky shromáždila více než 1000 sportovců – především juniorů a do 23 let – na závody na horských kolech, na silnici a na dráze. Jak víte, naše evropské satelitní centrum UCI WCC se nachází v Anadii a tato mistrovství dále osvětlila naše cyklistické aktivity v regionu.

V pátek 8. července jsem měl to potěšení přivítat prezidenta Katarské cyklistické federace pana Mohammeda Jahama Al-Kuwariho a generálního tajemníka pana Thani Khalifu Al Zarraa v sídle UCI. Strávili zde den, navštívili centrum a setkali se s členy našeho vrcholového managementu, aby pohovořili o všech aspektech cyklistiky v jejich zemi.

Na závěr bych rád upozornil na skutečnost, že naše výroční zpráva UCI za rok 2021, včetně naší Finanční zprávy, je nyní zveřejněna na webových stránkách UCI. Tento dokument obsahuje informace o pokroku, kterého jsme v průběhu roku dosáhli ve všech oblastech cyklistiky, a také naše finanční výsledky, které byly nad očekávání dobré. Zvu vás všechny k nahlédnutí do naší výroční zprávy UCI za rok 2021 <u>zde</u> .

Sports Directors' course

All the information related to the Sports Directors' course, which will be held between 31 October and 4 November 2022, is available on the <u>UCI website</u>. A letter has been sent to the teams required to register UCI certified Sports Directors.

Reminder Covid-19 protocol and special provisions

The updated <u>Covid-19 protocol for road races</u> came into force on 24 January 2022. As in previous years, national health rules will apply if they are stricter than the UCI rules. Conversely, in the case of less stringent national rules, the UCI rules shall apply. This <u>protocol</u> concerns the Elite, Under 23 and Junior, Men and Women categories and must be applied strictly.

- Organisers must upload the different requested documents on the dedicated platform at the latest 14 days before the start of their event. If changes occur after this deadline, for instance, a change in the list of participating teams, the organiser must inform the UCI as soon as possible.
- Teams who have not already done it must upload the vaccination/recovery certificates as soon as possible as well as a summary of the vaccination status of the team on the dedicated platform. The vaccination/recovery certificates are uploaded only once on the platform.
- Teams must also, before each event, upload the Excel file related to the UCI health-pass, on the dedicated platform. They will receive a reminder email before each event, describing the exact procedure to apply.
- National Federations must inform the organisers and teams under their responsibility, to ensure that procedures are respected.

In addition, all individuals in the race convoy must wear a mask, covering mouth and nose, at all times, including in vehicles. This is essential, as the softening of routine PCR testing measures only makes sense if the distancing and mask wearing measures remain strictly enforced.

The special provisions for road cycling, extended until 31 December 2022, are published on the **UCI website**.

Registration of trainee riders

As every year, the UCI Road Teams can register trainee riders within their roster for the end of the season. In this regard, an email has been sent to UCI Women's WorldTeams (art. 2.13.168), UCI WorldTeams (art. 2.15.110bis), UCI ProTeams (art. 2.16.033) as well as to National Federations responsible for UCI Women's Continental Teams (art. 2.17.008) and UCI Continental Teams (art. 2.17.008), in order to explain the procedure for registering trainee riders, which will be carried out on the UCI DataRide – Teams platform once again.

Exceptionally this year again, UCI Continental Teams, upon request, will be able to register trainee riders who are part of Men Elite category. In this respect, teams shall send a justified request for these riders, detailing the reasons for not registering a specific rider as a trainee rider when in the Under 23 category. These requests, which should be sent to the Road Unit (road@uci.ch), will be used to evaluate the current situation which will be presented to the UCI governing bodies in view of deciding whether regulations need to evolve or not.

In any case, it is mandatory for the trainee riders to be registered by **1** August. Should any issues be encountered, please contact us beforehand at **road@uci.ch**.

Instructions for UCI Road Teams' registration and key deadlines

The instructions for registration related to UCI Women's WorldTeams, UCI WorldTeams and UCI ProTeams have been sent to the concerned teams, who can now start the registration on the UCI DataRide – Teams and PwC Connect platforms. The first deadline to note, related to the submission of the licence application in particular, is on 15 August. The payment of the application fee (UCI Women's WorldTeams and UCI WorldTeams) and registration fee (UCI ProTeams) is due on 15 September.

The instructions for registration for UCI Women's Continental Teams and UCI Continental Teams will be sent to National Federations in the coming weeks. The registration procedure related to these teams' categories has not been modified for the 2023 season and can be found in Chapter 17 of Part 2 of the UCI Regulations.

2022 UCI Road World Championships

We kindly inform you that the General Information Bulletin has been updated and can be found on the <u>UCI website</u>. The Technical Guide will be published mid-August on our <u>UCI website</u>.

A document with all the entry requirements for the 2022 UCI Road World Championships in Australia has been published <u>on the UCI website</u>. The drug control form for nations planning to bring in medical equipment can be found <u>here</u>.

We inform you that it is mandatory to have an **international driving license** to drive an UCI Official car in Australia. For more information on how to apply for an international driving license, please refer to **this link**.

Please note that some visa applicants from specific countries (a complete list can be found at this <u>link</u>) may be required to go to a biometric data collection centre to provide their personal identifiers before their visa can be processed by the Department of Home Affairs.

The UCI invites National Federations to use the services offered by the Wollongong 2022 Travel Office, managed by global cycling tour operator Mummu Cycling, to assist with accommodation, transport and logistics. For more information, please click **here**.

Rider registration and accreditation procedure

Every nation participating in the 2022 UCI Road World Championships will be asked to register its riders for the different events via the <u>Online Registration System</u>, in accordance with the deadlines specified in article 9.2.004 of the UCI Regulations.

Team staff will be required to register via the Online Accreditation System to request accreditation. The system will open on **10 August 2022** at **this link**. A maximum number of accreditations is allocated for each National Federation and can be found on the **UCI website**.

UCI Seminar for National Federations

All National Federations are strongly encouraged to take part in the UCI Seminar for National Federations taking place during the 2021 UCI Road World Championships on Friday 23 September 2022 from 09.00 until 12.00.

The seminar will provide valuable information to National Federations regarding the use of the UCI DataRide platform, the 2023 UCI Cycling World Championships in Glasgow and Scotland, the UCI Integrity Guidelines, the UCI Solidarity programme, the UCI World Cycling Centre (WCC) satellite centres, Cycling for All and the UCI Sustainability Guidelines.

Regarding the UCI DataRide platform, individual meetings may also be planned with the National Federations upon request.

All National Federations will receive an official invitation to this seminar and a registration form to complete by 1 September 2022. If you require any further information, please contact international relations@uci.ch.

We would like to remind you that following the UCI Management Committee's approval, the 2022–2023 track season will start on 17 October 2022 and end on 31 December 2023. Team registrations will be valid for that entire period.

Anti-Doping Education

The Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI) is pleased to inform you that the next educational webinar organized by the International Testing Agency (ITA) will take place on <u>26 July 2022</u> and will focus on Therapeutic Use Exemptions (TUEs).

TUEs give riders the authorisation to participate in sporting competitions while using a medication or method of treatment that is prohibited as per the World Anti-Doping Agency's (WADA) Prohibited List. You will find here, the ITA dedicated paged for TUEs in cycling.

During this upcoming course, you will in particular have the opportunity to go through the following points:

- Who should apply for a TUE?
- Where and when can athletes apply?
- What are the criteria for granting a TUE, and how long does it take?
- Can I get a retroactive TUE?
- What if I need to renew a TUE?

In view of the importance of this topic for riders and riders support personnel, the UCI strongly encourages you and your members to attend this webinar which will be delivered in English, with simultaneous translation in Arabic, French, Spanish and Russian.


