As the 2023 UCI Cycling World Championships continue to power the bike, in collaboration with funders and partners to reach the start of 11 days of exhilaration, competition and the joy that cycling brings, we look forward to sharing this inaugural spectacle with the world!

The Championships are an event like no other. Not only will it bring over 8000 elite and amateur athletes from 13 UCI Cycling World Championships together for the first time, it will also inspire more people across Scotland and the world to get on a bike.

Hosted everywhere from metropolitan Glasgow to the Highlands of Fort William, the Championships is proudly a pan-Scotland event. 



Glasgow and Edinburgh are both served by frequent direct train services from London, and are easily reached from other main UK towns and cities, however, you may have to change trains en route.

A new fully electric east coast service operating between London and Edinburgh.

3. TRAVEL TO SCOTLAND

3.2 SUSTAINABLE TRAVEL GUIDANCE

As a purpose-led event, 2023 UCI Cycling World Championships is committed to embedding sustainability into our organisation, collaborating with our partners, and supporting our value chain to drive progress towards the *UN Sustainable Development Goals in Scotland*. Our sustainability framework has been mapped to indicators for measuring performance against contributions to the UN SDGs with social, economic, and environmental goals that are interdependent and mutually reinforcing.

As a sport we must demonstrate climate responsibility for attending the 2023 UCI Cycling World Championships, by mitigating these impacts wherever possible and compensating for our unavoidable emissions.

Taking climate action in this area means reducing the amount of travel and decarbonising the mode of transportation wherever possible.

These top five recommended actions can help guide more sustainable choices and decision making for your National Federation:

1. Fly direct: Direct flights generally use less fuel than flights with connections and are often more convenient for travellers.
2. If possible, consider the use of the ferry or international rail rather than flying, and for freight consider shipping rather than airfreight.
3. If hiring cars or other transport, seek fuel-efficient vehicles fitted with particle filters or low/zero-emission vehicles (electric or hybrid), and where possible increase vehicle sharing across your team to reduce use the number of vehicles and journeys.
4. Maximise the use of public transport and cycling rather than travelling by vehicle.
5. Choose the «greenest» travel option when travelling to and from airports: catching a bus or train from the airport has a far smaller carbon footprint than use of taxis or hire cars.

3.3 VISA PROCESS

Whether you need to apply for a visa to visit the UK depends on your nationality. If your country is on the list of visa nationals, you will need to apply for a visa before travelling to the UK. The visa national list can be found here: www.gov.uk/guidance/immigration-rules/immigration-rules-appendix-visitor-visa-national-list

If you do not require a visa to visit the UK, you do not need to apply for a visit visa to participate in UK-hosted events. You can apply for entry on arrival in the UK.

If you are not sure if you require a visa for the UK, please check if you need a UK visa on the UK Government website: <https://www.gov.uk/check-uk-visa>

If you are required to apply for a visa in advance of travel, please apply as early as possible to avoid delays.

Applications can be made up to three months in advance of your proposed date of travel.

2023 UCI Cycling World Championships can assist with an official invitation letter to support visa applications if required. Requests for these should be submitted via the National Federation's nominated Chef de Mission. The detailed information required and process for official invitation letters requests will be published in the early 2023. 3.4 UK CUSTOMS AND FREIGHT INFORMATION

National Federations, sponsors, suppliers and other client groups are responsible for arranging their own freight movements to and from Great Britain.

In accordance with British Law, all freight arriving into the United Kingdom (UK) will be subject to stringent customs processing on international arrival and departure.

Since the United Kingdom's formal withdrawal from the European Union and the end of the Brexit transitions period on 31 December 2022, the rules for the import of goods from outside the UK from EU countries have changed.

It is strongly recommended that clients use the services of a Licensed Customs Broker who is familiar with the specific import requirements to the UK. If you are planning on sending items in advance of your arrival, please allow additional time for customs clearance.

3.5 RADIO FREQUENCIES

Any teams, broadcasters, press and any other individuals planning to use radio equipment in the United Kingdom must apply for a radio license which will be issued by Ofcom (the regulator of communication services in the United Kingdom).

The application form can be requested from Radio.Spectrum@cyclingworldchamps.com

The form must be completed fully including invoicing and payment information. Ofcom will assign a frequency, generate an invoice and once the invoice is paid, Ofcom will issue the radio license.

Note: For License exempt devices, such as PMR446 radios, DECT (1.8/1.9Ghz), Wi-Fi Access points, Mi-Fis and other devices that use license exempt spectrum, these must be registered with Radio.Spectrum@cyclingworldchamps.com

Spectrum applications will be accepted until March 2023. After this period Ofcom cannot guarantee that licences will be granted for the period of the Championships, so all teams are encouraged to apply as early as possible.

Note: 1. All devices licensed and license exempt will be subject to Test & Tag to ensure they conform to the Ofcom license of 2023 UCI Cycling World Championships
2. It is a criminal offence under the Wireless Telegraphy Act 2006 to operate equipment on licensed frequencies without a license

3.6 TEAM DOCTORS

The UK General Medical Council can offer Team Doctors a free, limited professional registration to cover the period of the Championships. The advantages of taking up the offer of the free temporary registration is for team doctors to be able to write private prescriptions and access health care treatment without asking the Championships medical team for assistance.




ROAD COMPETITION MAP - GLASGOW


ROAD COMPETITION MAP - EDINBURGH


ROAD COMPETITION MAP - LOCH LOMOND








MOUNTAIN BIKE DOWNHILL MAP - FORT WILLIAM






