MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT



Dear members,

The Classics season draws to a close as I write this message, and what a season it has been! We have witnessed first-class battles in both the UCI WorldTour and UCI Women's WorldTour, and now look forward to the next stage races, such as the Tour de Romandie and Giro d'Italia for the men and the Vuelta España Femenina by Carrefour.es for the women.

The WHOOP UCI Mountain Bike World Series is under way, with the first two rounds taking place in Araxa - Minas Gerais, Brazil, at the beginning of the month. It promises to be an exceptional year with a total of 15 rounds between now and October, punctuated by the UCI Mountain Bike World Championships in Valais, Switzerland, where 27 titles of UCI World Champion will be awarded in almost all of the discipline's formats between 30 August and 14 September. Meanwhile, the first round of the UCI World Cup for mountain bike Eliminator powered by citymountainbike.com was raced in Dushanbe, Tajikistan, earlier this month.

Preparations continue full steam ahead for the 2027 UCI Cycling World Championships, that will take place in Haute-


Savoie, France. We were able to reveal several details about the second edition of this major combined event at a press conference organised in Sallanches (France) on 15 April. I invite you to read more about this in the Spotlight section of this newsletter.

On behalf of the UCI, I thank them for their commitment to the growth of our sport and wish them every success as they take on these important leadership roles.

REMINDER: Training compensation fees

We would like to remind National Federations that following the introduction of the training compensation fee, they are responsible for sending invoices to professional teams at the time of a rider's first neo-professional contract.

In order to support the National Federation with this task, a document listing the riders eligible for registration with 2025 professional teams, together with all the relevant information, has been sent to them. In the event of any doubts or difficulties with this system, the UCI Road Department's riders and teams unit remains at the disposal of the National Federations.

REMINDER: UCI Sport Directors' course

We remind you that the 2025 UCI Sport Directors' course will take place from 27 to 31 October 2025 at the UCI World Cycling Centre (WCC) in Aigle, Switzerland. All information concerning the course, including how women can apply for a scholarship to attend, is available on the UCI website. Teams that are obliged to employ UCI-certified Sport Directors have been contacted.

Furthermore, the list of UCI-certified Sport Directors is available on the UCI website, enabling teams to contact Sport Directors who have obtained the UCI certification.

2025 National Road Championships - registration

National Federations are invited to ensure that their 2025 National Road Championships are registered on the UCI International Calendar. The registration form is available on the National Federations' and Organisers' platform and is to be sent through this link.

In addition, we remind you that where Elite and Under 23 riders compete in the same event at their National Championships (same start and same finish), points shall be awarded for their position in the race classification, according to the event's Elite points scale.

For riders to be awarded UCI points, the event must be registered on the UCI International Calendar beforehand, and the results uploaded in UCI DataRide no later than two days after the final day of the event (art. 1.2.029 of the UCI Regulations).

2025 UCI Road World Championships (21-28 September 2025)

The 2025 UCI Road World Championships will take place from 21 to 28 September in Kigali, Rwanda. More information about the event can be found on the UCI website.

Online education on anti-doping



Education is key to keep cycling clean. Each member of the cycling community has a role to play and is strongly encouraged to familiarise themselves with their rights and responsibilities.

If you would like to improve your knowledge, the WADA's online anti-doping education and learning platform (ADEL) is at your disposal. The platform is interactive and available in several languages. Its mission is to meet the anti-doping education needs for all athletes, coaches, medical personnel and stakeholders.

In view of this, the UCI strongly encourages and recommends you and your members to increase your knowledge by browsing the ADEL platform and following the available modules, such as:

- ADEL for International/National-Level Athletes,
- · ADEL for Registered Testing Pool Athletes,
- ADEL for High Performance Coaches,
- Athlete and Athlete Support Personnel Guide to the 2025 list (English) etc.

Furthermore, please note that as part of the UCI Anti-Doping Education Program, all riders included in the UCI Registered Testing Pool or the UCI Testing Pool shall successfully complete an Anti-Doping education course i.e. International Level Athletes Education Program or otherwise equivalent program approved by the UCI.

2025 UCI Mobility & Bike City Forum x Copenhagen Cycling Summit: keynote speakers announced and registration open

The Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI) and the **City of Copenhagen** (Denmark) are pleased to invite you to the seventh edition of the UCI Mobility & Bike City Forum, which will be hosted jointly with the Copenhagen Cycling Summit on 20-21 June 2025 at the Danish Architecture Centre (DAC / BLOX).

Taking place in one of the leading cycling cities of the world - Copenhagen - the Forum is organised in collaboration with **Sport Event Denmark** and **Wonderful Copenhagen**. It will take place in parallel with the first edition of the **Copenhagen Sprint**, a new event on the calendars of the UCI Women's WorldTour and the UCI WorldTour taking place on Saturday 21 June (for the women) and Sunday 22 June (for the men).

The Forum will bring together decision-makers from four key sectors - public, private, civil society, and academia – as well as representatives of the UCI Bike City and Region network, National Federations, UCI partners, and the cycling industry. On the first day of the Forum, participants will share best practices and recommendations on how we can shape the future of active mobility. The second day will be dedicated to cycling tours and workshops, with several opportunities to witness the Copenhagen Sprint and the event's public cycling festival.

The conference will feature the following highlights, among others:

- Opening keynote by Janette Sadik Khan Former Commissioner of the New York City Department of Transportation, Board Chair of the Global Designing Cities Initiative and Principal, Bloomberg Associates
- Perspectives on cycling policy as a foundation for city planning from the Secretary of Mobility of Bogotá (Colombia) Claudia Diaz
- A new approach to cycling funding with the World Resource Institute's Deputy Director of Global Urban Mobility
 Claudia Adriazola-Steil
- Launch of the new Ride & Learn programme by the UCI and Peace & Sport.

As expert speakers are still being confirmed, more details regarding the content and format of the two-day event will be updated accordingly and accessible here. The full programme will be published and shared with all registered delegates in May 2025.

Haute-Savoie gearing up for 2027 UCI Cycling World Championships

The second UCI Cycling World Championships, which will take place from 24 August to 5 September 2027 in Haute-Savoie, France, are taking shape. Building on the undisputed success of the first edition of this event organised in Glasgow and across Scotland (United Kingdom) in 2023, the event in Haute-Savoie will see 20 UCI World Championships take place at 12 sites where a total of 281 titles of UCI World Champion will be at stake.
